Special Issue of *Housing and Society*

“Green and Sustainable Housing”

You are invited to submit a manuscript for the Special Issue of *Housing and Society* themed “Green and Sustainable Housing,” guest edited by Suk-Kyung Kim, Ph.D., Associate Professor of Interior Design at the School of Planning, Design, & Construction at Michigan State University.

Housing and Society is a peer-reviewed research journal of the Housing Education and Research Association. It has been contributing to the theory development and knowledge building in housing and related issues over the past four decades. Topics have been varied covering housing policy, finance, affordability, human behavior, design, management, neighborhood, and community.

As part of the effort to develop and promote sustainable housing and envisioning the future direction for achieving housing sustainability, the journal is sponsoring a special issue on “Green and Sustainable Housing.” The special issue invites authors to submit scholarly papers based on their research, teaching, and extension efforts, theory, or professional practices in design, development, construction, or management.

Scholarly papers that focus on housing, neighborhoods, and communities in terms of sustainability and being green are welcome. Example topics are:

- Sustainable Housing Design and Development
- Green Building Programs and Housing
- Occupants’ Satisfaction, Behaviors, or Perceptions about Green Housing
- Energy Efficiency Measurements or Management
- Greening Public Housing or Rental Housing
- Zero-Energy Homes or Neighborhoods
- Housing Affordability and Being Green or Sustainable
- Value Analysis In Design Decision-Making
- Housing Policy and Support Programs for Sustainability
- Occupant Education for Green and Sustainable Housing

Submitted manuscripts should not have been published previously, nor be under consideration for publication elsewhere (except conference proceedings papers). All manuscripts are refereed through a blind peer-review process.

Submission process:

- By **March 1, 2015**, submit an electronic version in Word® of your manuscript as an email attachment and note “special issue submission-sustainable housing” in the subject line to kimsk@msu.edu. The editor will remove your name and affiliation for the blind-review process.
- Also, mail a \$35 check made out to HERA to cover the review fee to Suk-Kyung Kim, Guest Editor, School of Planning, Design, & Construction, Michigan State University, 552 W. Circle Dr. Human Ecology 201 B, East Lansing, MI 48824.

- Authors should follow the journal of *Housing and Society* guidelines for manuscript submission (see guidelines at <http://www.housingeducators.org/MEMAREA/HandSJmanguidelines.shtml>).
- All manuscripts will go through a blind-review process with final decisions regarding acceptance for publication by June 1, 2015.
- Publication of the special issue will be in 2015.
