

## TRAVEL DIRECTIONS TO UMASS LOWELL INN & CONFERENCE CENTER, LOWELL FROM LOGAN AIRPORT

### **A. Public Transportation to Lowell:**

1. At Logan Airport, you can take the [BLUE LINE MBTA SUBWAY LINE](https://t.mbta.com/schedules/Blue/line) (<https://t.mbta.com/schedules/Blue/line>) to GOVERNMENT CENTER. \$2.25 ONE WAY \$4.50 ROUND TRIP
2. From GOVERNMENT CENTER switch onto the [GREEN LINE MBTA SUBWAY LINE](#).
3. You will head towards LECHMERE, but pass Haymarket station and get off at NORTH STATION.
4. At North Station, walk upstairs into the Boston Garden and get onto the Commuter Rail – [LOWELL LINE](https://t.mbta.com/schedules/CR-Lowell/timetable). (<https://t.mbta.com/schedules/CR-Lowell/timetable>)
5. If you walk to a teller and purchase a ticket, it is \$10.00 ONE WAY \$20.00 ROUND TRIP. If purchased on the train, it will cost a few extra dollars.

### **After arriving in Lowell:**

6. Once at the Lowell Commuter Rail Station, (**101 Thorndike Street, Lowell, MA 01852**), you can take a [taxi / Uber / Lyft](#) to the UMass Lowell ICC at 50 Warren St. [Luna Taxi](#) is a Lowell Taxi service. The ICC is around 0.9 miles from the Station.
  - Uber / Lyft prices can range from \$5.00 to \$7.30
  - Luna Taxi prices can range from \$8.00 to \$10.00
7. Getting to the UMass Lowell ICC from the Rail Station (or also known as Robert B. Kennedy Bus Transfer Center which is just next to the Station) via Lowell Regional Transit Authority (LRTA) buses. It takes around 11min. All LRTA buses are \$1.00s.
  - At the Robert B. Kennedy Bus Transfer Center, you can ride **Bus #3** bus with 2 STOPS to CHURCH ST & LAWRENCE ST. (<http://lrta.com/schedules/route-3-south-lowell/#route-map>)
  - From CHURCH ST & LAWRENCE ST **walk down** (3 min) to CHURCH ST and take a slight right onto GREEN ST.
  - Stay on GREEN ST until you reach GEORGE ST and take a right onto GEORGE ST.
  - Continue on GEORGE ST until it merges with WARREN ST, which by then you should be able to see the UMass Lowell Inn & Conference Center towards the left of GEORGE ST.

8. Getting to the UMass Lowell ICC from Robert B. Kennedy Bus Transfer Center via walking: (15-17min) -0.9 mile

- Walk left from the entrance of the Robert B. Kennedy Bus Transfer Center towards THORNDIKE ST and CROSS the street towards the park.
- Once across the street walk towards the bridge until you reach MIDDLESEX ST which will be the THIRD INTERESTION TO YOUR RIGHT.
- Stay on MIDDLESEX ST until you arrive at a large intersection where MIDDLESEX ST MEETS CENTRLE ST.
- Cross the street going towards GREEN ST straight across from MIDDLESEX ST directly next to a red brick building.
- Walk down GREEN ST until you reach GEORGE ST and take a left.
- Continue on GEORGE ST until it merges with WARREN ST, which by then you should be able to see the UMass Lowell Inn & Conference Center towards the left of GEORGE ST.

### **B. Taxi, Uber & Lyft services from Logan Airport to Lowell:**

Taxi and Uber / Lyft fares to and from Boston Logan Airport to Lowell will be about **\$65-70 one way**.
