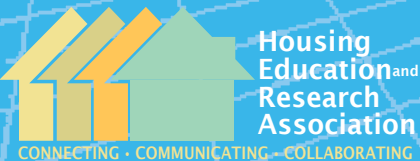

Subscription to the Research Journal
The official publication of HERA is the journal, *Housing and Society*. Two issues of the journal are published annually.

Annual Conference
HERA's annual conference is scheduled in a different geographic region of the United States or international site each year. Topics of current housing issues are presented by members as well as state, national and international housing leaders. Sessions, posters and group discussions are held on the education, research and extension implications of current housing trends and research. Conference proceedings include referred abstracts of papers presented.

Educational Resources
HERA has available on-line and for purchase educational resources developed by members and committees. These include teaching tips and classroom /program ideas.

Tessie Agan Scholarship
An annual paper competition is held for graduate and undergraduate students. First place winners have the opportunity to present their papers at the annual conference or receive a cash award. The scholarship fund is maintained with tax-deductible contributions from the membership.

The Membership Year is January 1st to December 31st.

MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES

Active/Affiliate
Any person/organization interested in the purposes of HERA is eligible for active/affiliate membership. These members have voting privileges and receive the *Housing and Society* journal. Organizations will have one person designated as the group's representative and receive the journal and voting membership. (Libraries are not eligible).

Student
Persons enrolled as students on at least a half-time basis are eligible for student membership. Student members receive the *Housing and Society* journal but do not have voting privileges. (Former active members who return to student status during graduate study do not lose their voting rights.)

Emeritus
Any retired person who was formerly an active member may join as an emeritus member with all the benefits and privileges of active membership.
