Sioux Falls, the largest city in South Dakota, is named for the Sioux tribe of American Indians and the waterfalls of the Big Sioux River. The Sioux tribe named the water Minne Waukon (sacred water). The falls are located at Falls Park, a popular tourist attraction located a few blocks from the conference hotel. Many of the venerable reminders of Sioux Falls' pioneer past were constructed out of the region's distinctive rose quartzite and serve as testimony to the founders' hard work, vision and commitment to community. Many of the city's older buildings made of this rose quartzite are still standing today.

Sioux Falls has approximately 200,000 residents and is home to several employers in the financial services industry, including Citi, First PREMIER Bank/PREMIER Bankcard, and Sammons Financial Group.
